Read the Appeal Brief - It's Good!

Our appeal brief was filed in September. The City and Kulima have until early December to submit their Answering Briefs and we will have another three weeks to Reply to their briefs. Then all of the documents will be reviewed by the Judges on the Intermediate Court of Appeals.

The brief clearly shows how the City failed to follow Hawaii Environmental Law by not taking a "Hard Look" at whether or not a Supplemental EIS is needed for the Turtle Bay Resort Expansion Project.
